At our last school council meeting, we announced that the school would hire a Child and Youth Care Worker to enhance support for our students further. We look forward to this additional support for our students. We will strive toward improving the school's climate through increased emphasis on digital citizenship and appropriate interpersonal relationships for students as we return to normal post-pandemic. Furthermore, we will continue to align our actions and approaches to support the standards of behaviour that our community expects.

We know it is crucial that we work together to actualize the principles of being proactive, beginning with the end in mind and seeking first to understand. Working together is essential for a positive school culture that ensures everyone is treated with dignity and respect. 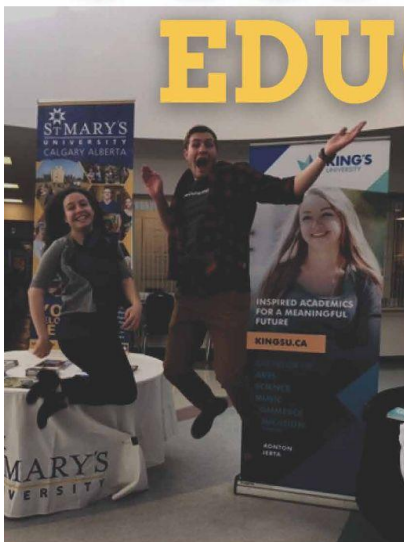
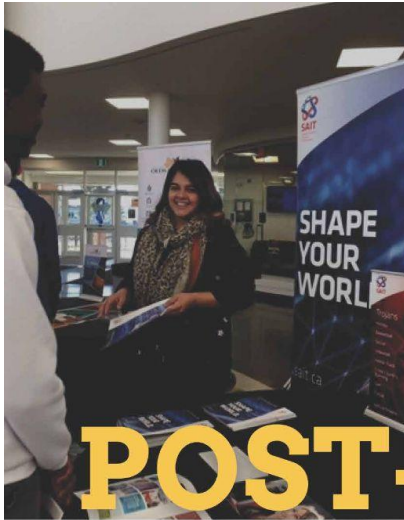
