# Principal's Message - Mr. MacDonald

#### Online Bullying Awareness

As we navigate through the digital age, the issue of cyberbullying has become increasingly prevalent, affecting the well-being and mental health of students. We are committed to making efforts to create environments where our students feel welcome, safe, and cared for both in the physical and digital realm.

Cyberbullying refers to digital communication between platforms such as social media, messaging apps, or other online platforms to harass, intimidate, or harm others. It can take various forms, including spreading rumours, sharing harmful comments or images, excluding others, or impersonating someone to damage their reputation.

This year, JT Foster has made efforts to make students aware of the importance of digital citizenship by harnessing programs by working collaboratively with our local RCMP and harnessing information from awareness from research-based documentaries such as Screenagers: Growing Up in the Digital Age.

Despite our efforts, the research is clear that irresponsible use of personal devices supports the conclusion that personal devices are not only harmful to children's mental health but also their ability to learn. This is extremely concerning, given the most recent research. After consultation with our staff and school council community, we are strongly considering taking action on regulating in-school cell phone use in the 2024-25 school year.

Finally, on Monday, May 6th, we are inviting Cst. Erik Grant from the Nanton RCMP to discuss cyberbullying and digital citizenship with our grade 7 class.
