






THE SURVEY SAYS:

Over 100 of our LRSD grade 12 students responded to a short survey about their plans after graduation. We discovered that 96.5% of our respondents are planning to pursue some form of post secondary studies within 5 years of graduating high school, with 85.6% of those students preferring to stay within Alberta for their college, polytechnic or university studies. Over 60% of our grade 12s plan to start their post secondary education in September 2025 with another 35% opting to begin studies in 2026 or 2027. Students are definitely looking for quality educational programming with a variety of outcomes from one year certificates to four year degrees.







DEADLINES APPROACHING...

Schulich Scholarship Nominees - 1 per high school must be submitted by January 29, 2025. If you are a grade 12 student considering attending one of 20 universites to study a STEM program in September 2025, talk to your school principal to see if you may be considered for this \$100,000 - \$120,000 award.
