Letter(s) of recommendation or reference MUST accompany your application. It is suggested that coaches, teachers, employers, or other adults who know you well, and are not related to you, are individuals from whom you might consider requesting these letters.

Completed applications **MUST BE MAILED** to **Box 124, Nanton, Alberta TOL 1R0**. They must be post marked no later than Apr. 30th of the year in which the application is made.

INDIVIDUALS WRITING A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION PLEASE COMMENT ON THE FOLLOWING:

- How long have you known the applicant
- In what capacity have you come to know or coach the applicant
- For how many years / seasons have you been associated with the applicant
- What are the applicant's strengths and weaknesses

If you are specifically writing as a coach please address the following:

- What knowledge do you have of other sports in which the applicant competes
- To what levels of competition did the applicant progress
- Describe the applicant's "heart and hustle" as a player

- Describe the applicant's interaction with own teammates, and with opponents
- Overall impression

ANY LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICANT'S SUBMISSION, BUT MAY BE PLACED IN A SEPARATELY SEALED ENVELOPE IF THE INDIVIDUAL SUPPLYING THE LETTER SO CHOOSES.

<u>AMOUNT:</u>	A scholarship of \$xxx will be awarded each year.
<u>SELECTION COMMITTEE:</u>	<p>A committee consisting of appointed members shall be responsible to evaluate the applications each year and award a scholarship.</p> <p>The decision of the committee is final.</p>
<u>CRITERIA:</u>	
<u>Primary considerations:</u>	<p>Applicants must be a student who is attending J. T. Foster school, and is in his/her grade 12 graduating year.</p> <p>Applicants must have at least one letter of reference/recommendation included with the application form.</p> <p>Applicants must include a transcript of all high school courses completed.</p>
<u>Secondary considerations:</u>	<p>Based on variety of sport involvement, progression in levels of participation, "heart and hustle" as a sports enthusiast, as well as interaction with teammates and opponents.</p> <p>Based on success in courses appropriate/consistent with applicant's post-secondary educational pursuits.</p> <p>Based on community involvement as an individual or as part of family.</p> <p>Based on agricultural association.</p>

Proof of Enrolment should not be submitted with the application. However, it must be provided prior to the disbursement of funds. This proof can be submitted anytime during the 39 months following the June in which the award was granted.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DATES

Pre-printed application forms are available upon request from the office of the counsellor at J. T. Foster High School.

Applications will be accepted until April 30th of the applicant's graduating year.

A complete Transcript of Marks to date is to accompany the Application.

A letter(s) of recommendation must accompany the Application.

Application finalists may be called to present at an interview.

The recipient will be acknowledged with a certificate at the J.T. Foster Awards ceremony held in June each year; and the funds will be dispersed anytime in the 39 months that follow this presentation.

If in any given year the selection panel deems there was no suitable application, or no application that met the criteria or deadlines, the scholarship will not be awarded for that year.

The decision of the selection panel is final.
